Admission Materials

APPLICATION TO THE UNIVERSITY:

Complete the online application to the University and submit all of the required documentation. Graduate student admission requirements are located on the UAM website under Admissions & Aid.

School of Nursing

APPLICATION TO THE SCHOOL OF NURSING:

Complete the School of Nursing (SON) online application and upload your personal statement.

TRANSCRIPTS:

- Grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 or above (on a 4-point scale)
- Students with less than a 2.75 GPA may be considered if program space is available
- GPA is calculated on the last 60 undergraduate credit hours
- A letter grade of "C" or better in an undergraduate statistics course
- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended should be sent to the SON

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:

Contact two (2) persons for letters of reference which include one (1) person qualified to comment on your academic abilities and one (1) persons who can provide work-related (practice) information. An applicant is strongly encouraged to carefully choose persons who can comment on your current and potential contribution to nursing. Indicate the names on the application form. The reference form is included below for you to give to your references who will forward them to the School of Nursing. Please provide your references with a stamped envelope addressed to the School of Nursing.

PERSONAL STATEMENT:

Write a response to each of the six (6) questions listed below. Your response should be limited to five double-spaced typewritten pages. Upload your personal statement with the online application. This statement will be used to evaluate your ability in written self-expression and the congruency of your goals and interests with the field of study and program aims.

Written response to these six questions is limited to five double-spaced typewritten pages.

- 1. Why are you pursuing a graduate nursing degree in public health?
- 2. Please describe your qualifications and readiness for graduate study.
- 3. Briefly describe a problem area in public health nursing you think you would like to focus on for your capstone project.
- 4. What do you envision as potential contributions you will make to public health nursing?
- 5. What are your long-range career plans in nursing?
- 6. Why did you specifically select the MSN in Public Health at the University of Arkansas at Monticello? Please include why this program is best suited to meet your educational and career goals
