The Council approved the July 9, 2008 minutes.

The Council discussed retention ideas. Mr. Ray stated that Ms. Crystal Ratliff will be providing Weevil Winners Forum, a training session for incoming new freshman, on July 30. Dr. Doss stated that the School of Education will be offering special topics course in reading this fall.

Mr. Bobby Hoyle updated the Council on the ARE\_ON system. He stated that Mike Abbiatti, David Merrifield, and Bill Ashmore will be on campus August 21 to give UAM a progress report and to talk about opportunities associated with the Arkansas Research and Education Optical Network.

Mr. Jay Jones updated the Council on the renovation to the Wells Hall and Sorrells Hall, Information Technology, and Press Box and new construction of practice facility. He talked about the administration software (Web CT 6.0).

Ms. Carol Dolberry discussed with the Council class scheduling for the spring. Mr. Ray suggested we should offer additional classes at night and weekend to increase our enrollment. Mr. Ray encouraged Unit Heads to begin working on class schedules for the Spring 2009 and summer school. Dr. Ranelle Eubanks stated that the Early College High School Program currently has 436 students enrolled in the fall.
