The Council approved a proposal from the Registrar's Office to require a graduation degree audit for graduate students effective Spring 2011. The proposal reads as follows:

Graduation Degree Audit Requirement for Graduate Students

Following completion of 12 graduate-level hours and prior to the completion of 15 graduate-level hours, graduate students must have a degree audit on file in the Office of the Registrar. Graduate students who have completed 15 graduate-level hours must have a signed audit on file to register for the next term. Audits must include the signature of the student, advisor, unit head, and registrar.

3. Modify Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.) Required Program of Study

5. Remove EDUC 5053 Public School Law for Teachers as part of the required program of study for the Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.) effective Summer I 2011.
