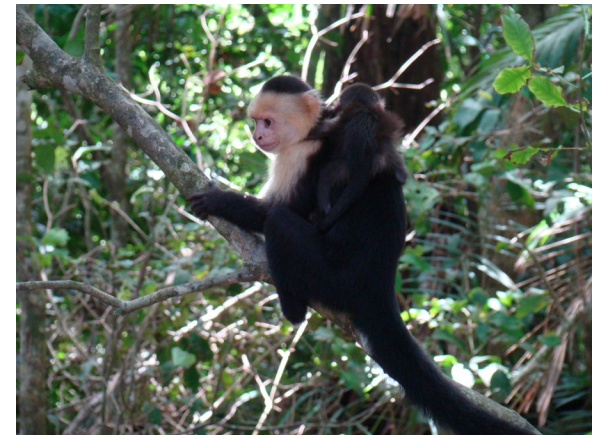

Study Abroad Program

Undergraduate students can earn up to nine (9) credit hours and



graduate students can earn up to six (6) credit hours in a Spanish speaking country. Students will live with a family of the host

country and are required to speak Spanish at all times.

Objectives of the Study Abroad Program are:

> To develop oral proficiency in Spanish through a total immersion program.

> To develop an awareness and understanding of the culture of the host country through family life, field trips, cultural activities and daily life in the host country.

Prices*:

- UAM Tuition six (6) or nine (9) credit hours:
\$120.00 per credit hour (undergraduate)
\$180.00 per credit hour (graduate)
(Based on in-state residence)
- Airfare from Little Rock:
\$700.00 *(Approximate cost)*
- Costa Rica program fee 3 weeks
(Monteverde/Heredia) - \$1470.00
(Price includes home stay, 2 meals per day, private room, laundry service, and all books and workbooks for classes)
- Sight-seeing tours:
\$500 *(Approximate cost)*
- Lunch, transportation and other incidentals: \$400.00
- Airport pick-up and direct transfer to Monteverde: \$35 per student

Enrollment and Payment:

Participants must submit an application form along with their \$250 deposit by February 15, 2010. **(Deposits are non-refundable after April 15, 2010.)**
