RETURN OF TITLE IV FUNDS: Students who receive Title IV aid and do not complete at least 60% of the semester for which they are enrolled may be required to return a portion of the Federal funds received. Title IV aid includes Pell Grants, SEOG, ACG, SMART Grant, TEACH Grant, Perkins Loans, Stafford Loans and PLUS Loans. In most cases the withdrawal date for students who officially withdraw will be the actual date of withdrawal as determined by the Registrar's Office. Students who cease attending without officially withdrawing are considered "unofficial withdrawals." The midpoint of the semester (or in some cases, the last date of attendance) will be used in determining the amount of aid to be returned for unofficial withdrawals. WITHDRAWALS FROM THE UNIVERSITY, EITHER OFFICIALLY OR UNOFFICIALLY, MAY REQUIRE THAT YOU RETURN A SUBSTANTIAL AMOUNT OF THE TITLE IV FUNDS THAT YOU RECEIVED. IF YOU SHOULD HAVE TO WITHDRAW AT ANY POINT, CONTACT THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE.
