## Residence Hall / Apartment Information:

### Bankston Hall

Bankston Hall is a three-story all-male residence hall. Amenities include a game room, study room, spacious TV lounge, kitchenette, and a 24-hour quiet floor (third floor). All rooms are furnished. Private rooms are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Free tutoring is available on a weekly basis. Internet access available.

### Horsfall Hall

Horsfall is an all-female residence hall. Amenities include a 24-hour quiet floor, study room, two spacious TV lounges, kitchenette, vending area, laundry facility, and game area. All rooms are furnished. Private rooms are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Free tutoring is available on a weekly basis. Internet access available.

### Maxwell Hall

Maxwell Hall is a two-story suite-style residence hall that houses both male and female students. Each suite consists of two double-occupancy rooms divided by a bathroom. All rooms are furnished. Amenities include a laundry facility, vending area, and two TV lounges, which include table tennis, air hockey, and foosball games. No private rooms are available. All rooms are double occupancy. Internet access available.

### Royer Hall

Royer Hall is a three-story all-female residence hall. Amenities include an exercise room, study lounge, spacious lobby, a cozy TV room, a 24-hour quiet floor, kitchenette with microwave and refrigerator, vending area and laundry facility. All rooms are furnished. Single private rooms are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Free tutoring is available on a weekly basis. Internet access available.

### University Apartments

The University Apartments provide students with a comfortable living transition from living in the residence halls to independent living, and consist of two co-residential buildings housing approximately 48 students each. Each apartment includes a living room, two bedrooms, one bath, and a kitchenette. Each apartment is fully furnished. An outside storage area is provided for each apartment. Laundry facilities and vending machines are located on the first floor of each building. Amenities included are utilities, basic cable, internet access, and local phone service. Each bedroom provides separate internet, phone and cable connections in addition to a cable connection in the living room.

I understand that if I withdraw from school, I will forfeit my deposit and be responsible for room and board charges incurred. I also understand that if I move out of the halls before the end of the semester without withdrawing from school, I will be responsible for board charges incurred and I will forfeit my deposit and rent for the entire semester. I also understand that if I withdraw from school or am administratively withdrawn, I will need to vacate my residence hall room within 24 hours of my withdrawal. I understand that I may cancel this application and receive a refund of my room deposit by contacting the Residence Life Office, in writing, before August 15 (if the application is for the academic year) or December 22 (if the application is for the spring semester only) and on the first day of class for Summer I and II. I agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the University of Arkansas at Monticello and the Residence Life Office and contract conditions, and I agree that they constitute a part of this application and subsequent contract. Damage deposits may be forfeited if damages are incurred. I may be charged for excessive damages exceeding the deposit.*
