Beg/Jr./Sr. High: June 11 - 15

When You Arrive...

<u>CHECK – IN:</u> 11AM – 2PM

- All students should check in to their dorms upon arrival. Dorm assignments will be sent the week before camp. The addresses to all buildings on campus are provided at the bottom of this letter.
- Access to UAM's wireless internet (wifi) will not be available to campers, therefore, please make necessary arrangements.
- The first meal we provide is dinner on Tuesday and the last meal we provide is lunch on Saturday. If you would like to eat lunch with your camper before the concert, you must purchase a meal in the cafeteria.

The following will take place at check in:

You will be issued a key to the room that you will be staying in.

This will be returned at the end of camp! If a key is lost, it will cost \$75 to replace.

You will receive a lanyard and button that you can keep your room key on.

This will be the way you will be admitted to the dining hall!

You will receive a schedule of events for the week.

AUDITIONS: 12PM – 3PM

IMMEDIATELY after you check in, you may take your things to your assigned room, then it's time to audition for your chair placement. There will be signs posted and counselors to help you find the specific building and room you'll be in for auditions.

After you complete your audition, you may return to your residence hall to unpack your belongings.

AUDITION RESULTS AND CAMP MEETING: 4:00 PM

All campers will be taken to the Fine Arts Center Auditorium by counselors at 4PM to hear the results of auditions. Campers will be assigned a specific chair and band that they will participate in for the remainder of the week and perform with on the final day of camp!

CHECK OUT:

All campers must be checked out of their room PRIOR to their concert.

Concerts will be on the last day of each camp at the Fine Arts Center Auditorium on the UAM campus. Concerts begin at 12:30pm.
