## 2008-09 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL RELEASE

**Birmingham, AL**—An exciting Saturday capped the 2008-09 Gulf South Conference Men's Basketball regular season.

The next stop for 10 teams is the state-of-the-art, 9,000-seat, DeSoto Civic Center in Southaven, MS which hosts the GSC Men's and Women's Tournaments for the third straight season. The 2009 GSC Men's Basketball Tournament begins with two Opening Round contests on Wednesday, March 4th followed by the remaining rounds from March 6-8.

Three post-season berths and the two Divisional Titles were up for grabs this past Saturday.

**Christian Brothers** and **Delta State** entered the final day tied atop the West Division, but CBU took advantage of DSU's upset loss at **Henderson State**, earning the Bucs their first-ever No. 1 West seed. **Valdosta State** took care of business on Saturday, claiming the top East Division spot thanks to a victory at **West Florida**.

UWF's loss opened up the door for **West Alabama** which punched its first Tournament ticket since 1998 via a 60-48 victory at in-state rival **Montevallo**. Despite UM's setback, the Falcons advanced to the post-season over UWF thanks to a previous win over No. 1 seed VSU.

**Harding** and **Southern Arkansas** wrapped up the day tied for fifth in the West Division standings, but HU prolonged its campaign via a win over No. 1 seed CBU.

The GSC Title will not be the only thing up for grabs this week, as the league champion receives an automatic bid to the 64-team NCAA Division II Tournament.

Last but not least, GSC basketball returns to the airwaves for the fourth consecutive season when Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast, Cox Sports, Cleveland, MS affiliate WHCQ and MediaCom provide live coverage of the Men's and Women's the Championship Games (check with your local cable company for availability; games not available on DirectTV or Dish Network).

Fans can also follow the entire Tournament **LIVE** on the official GSC Tournament Home Page ([www.gulfsouthconference.org](http://www.gulfsouthconference.org)). Features include **Penn Atlantic Broadband Internet Broadcasts** and **Live In-Game Statistics** and for every game, **GSC Tournament Blog**, **game recaps** and **daily video wrap-ups**. Additional coverage can also be found at the **GSC Fan Page on Facebook**.

The action begins Wednesday, March 5 with Opening Round games scheduled for 2:45 p.m. and 7:30. The Quarter-Finals will take place on Friday at 12:30 p.m., 2:45, 5:30 and 7:30. The Semi-Finals are slated for 5:30 p.m. and 7:30 on Saturday, while Sunday's Championship Game is tentatively set for 2:45 p.m.

# GSC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

**WEEK 14**

*(for the week ending 03/02/08)*

### EAST DIVISION

**Alabama-Huntsville center Cody Jones** (JR, 6-7, 220, Churubusco, IN).

Jones collects his first-ever honor, leading UAH to an 86-77 home win over in-region foe Flagler.

The junior capped the regular season, recording his second double-double of the season behind a career-high 37 points and a season-best 14 rebounds along with five assists. The Churubusco, IN native shot 60.0 percent from the floor, was 1-for-2 from beyond the arc and was 66.7 from the foul line.

### WEST DIVISION

**Henderson State forward Martin Mitchell** (FR, 6-0, 185, Toledo, OH).

Mitchell earns his first-ever accolade after helping HSU wrap up the season with a pair of victories. The freshman averaged 16.5 points, 3.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists in 31.5 minutes, while firing 55.6 percent from the field, 80.0 percent from three-point range and 90.0 percent from the charity stripe.

Mitchell started the week guiding the Reddies to a 68-57 road win over cross-street Ouachita Baptist. The Toledo, OH native scored a team-high 15 points in 34 minutes along with three rebounds and five assists. He saved his best for last in Henderson State's 84-68 home upset of No. 25 Delta State, pouring in a game-high 18 points and adding four assists and three boards in 29 minutes.

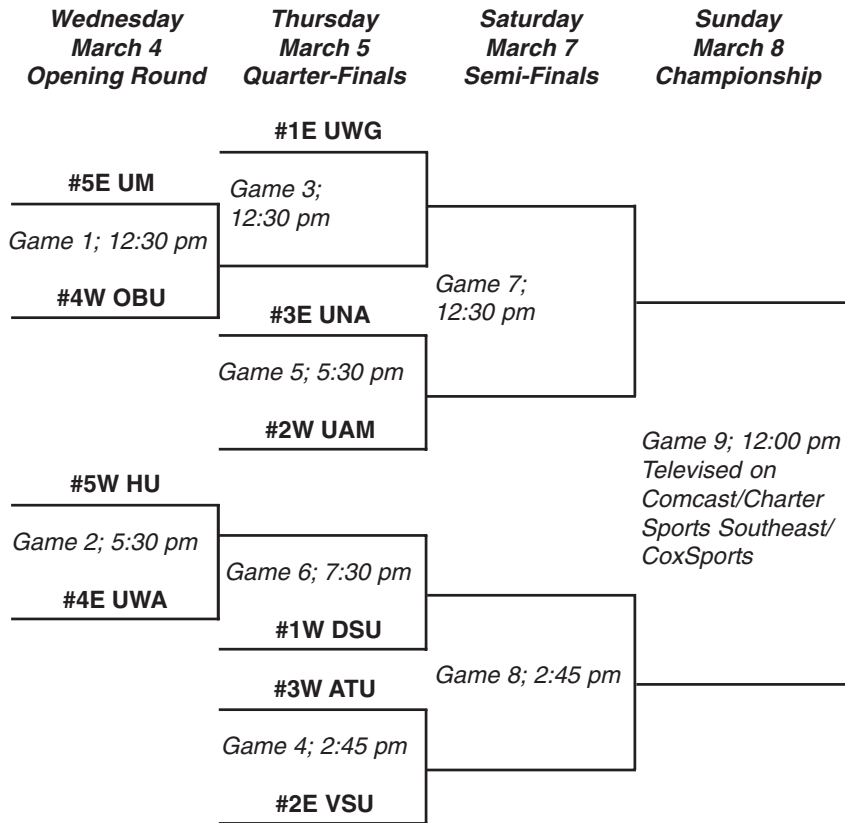

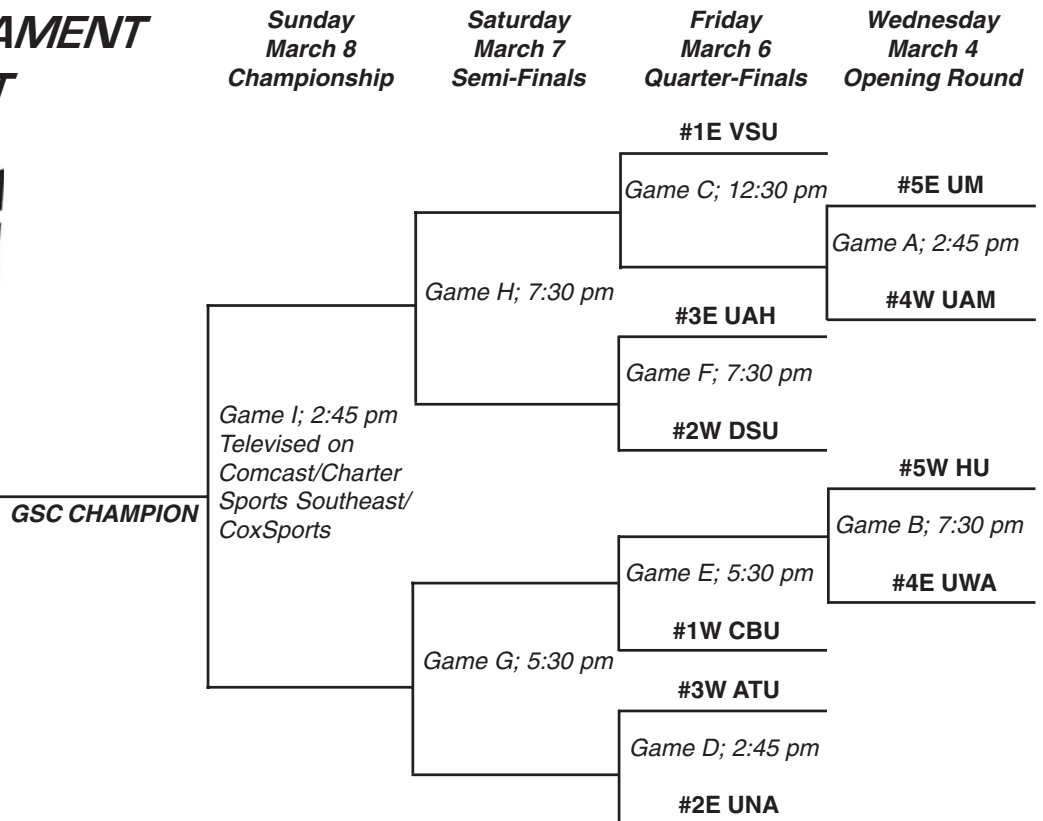

## 2009 GSC MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT GAME PREVIEWS

### OPENING ROUND—WEDNESDAY, MARCH 4

**Game A—E5 Montevallo** (15-15, 5-7) vs. **W4 Arkansas-Monticello** (19-8, 8-6)—2:45 p.m.

Its déjà vu all over again when **No. 4 West seed Arkansas-Monticello** faces **No. 5 East seed Montevallo**. The squads met in the same positions last year with UAM claiming a 63-61 triumph. UM hopes the third time will be the charm in its third clash versus the Boll Weevils this season. Arkansas-Monticello won both regular season matchups, 67-53, at a neutral site and 71-62 in Monticello. The contest marks the third overall time that the teams have clashed at the Tournament with UM ousting the Boll Weevils in the 2006 Semi-Finals, 80-71. Montevallo holds a 9-4 edge in the all-time series.

Montevallo makes its seventh post-season appearance, while going 11-3. The Falcons have advanced to four Finals, taking home the trophy in 2004, 2005 and 2006. UM is 0-4 versus West foes this season and is 2-10 versus the Tournament field.

Arkansas-Monticello returns to the GSC Tournament for the fourth time in five seasons. UAM has advanced to five previous tournaments, going 4-5 led by three Semi-Finals showings (2001, 2005 and 2006). The Boll Weevils is a perfect 3-0 versus the West this year and are 6-4 versus the Tournament field.

**KEY PLAYERS:** **Arkansas-Monticello forward Raymond Wright** is third in the Conference in scoring (17.9) and fifth in rebounds (8.1). **Forward Derek Easter** is fifth in blocks (1.58), while **guard Deron Brown** is eighth in three-point percentage (.397—48-121) and 10th in assists (3.08). **Montevallo guard Freddy Little** is an All-GSC First Team and is fifth in scoring (16.0), while **guard Terrill Humphrey** is second in free throw percentage (.835-79-95). All-GSC Second Team **forward Nate Flowers** is third in rebounding (8.6) and ninth in field goal percentage (.543—145-267).

**Game B—W5 Harding** (16-11, 6-8) vs. **E4 West Alabama** (13-14, 5-7)—7:30 p.m.

**No. 4 East seed West Alabama** and **No. 5 West seed Harding** take the hardwood for the first time ever in the second Quarter-Final game of the day. Each squad earned their way to the post-season last Saturday. UWA sewed up a spot with a win at in-state rival Montevallo, while Harding returned to Southaven via a home win over Arkansas foe Ouachita Baptist.

West Alabama makes its 11th overall appearance but its first since 1998. The Tigers are 6-9 in GSC Tournament play and claimed the Title in 1982. UWA is 1-1 versus the West Division this season and is 3-6 versus the field.

HU seeks a return to the GSC Championship Game after falling to Christian Brothers a year ago. The Bisons advanced to their seventh GSC Tournament, third in a row. They are 5-6 in those previous events, moving to the Semi-Finals in 1999 and 2007. Harding is 3-1 versus the East Division this season and 5-7 versus the Tournament field.

**KEY PLAYERS:** **All-GSC First Team forward Jason Swanson** leads West Alabama, placing fourth in rebounds (8.4) and sixth in scoring (15.9). Guard Chris Davis is tops in three-point percentage (.477—42-88), while Jonathan Griffin is fourth in field goal percentage (.589—83-141). **Harding** features a pair of All-GSC Second Team standouts in **guard Trent Morgan** and **forward Kevin Brown**. Morgan is sixth in steals (1.78), while Brown is sixth in field goal percentage (.571—132-231) and 10th in blocks (0.85). Not to be forgotten is **guard Steven Barnett** who is second in assists (5.30) and tied for eighth in steals (1.59).

### QUARTER-FINALS—FRIDAY, MARCH 6

**Game C—Arkansas-Monticello/Montevallo winner** vs. **E1 Valdosta State** (22-5, 9-3)—12:30 p.m.

East Division Champion and No. 1 seed **Valdosta State** faces the winner of Game A; **Arkansas-Monticello** or East rival **Montevallo**.

VSU is the hottest team in the Tournament, reeling off six in a row. The Blazers enter as the No. 1 East seed for the first time since 2004 and make their sixth consecutive post-season trip, 15th overall. Valdosta State is 8-14 in league Tournament action, advancing to the Finals in 1983 and 2002. They are 1-0 versus UAM and 19-13 versus UM all-time. Valdosta State has not faced a West Division foe this season but is 5-3 versus the Tournament field.

**KEY PLAYERS:** **Valdosta State forward Tyrone Curnell** was named First Team All-GSC and is second in the GSC rebounds (8.6), tied for second in steals (1.96) and is eighth in scoring (15.2) and blocks (1.33). **Forward Ray Cummings** is first in free throw percentage (.864—57-66).

**Game D—E2 North Alabama** (18-9, 8-4) vs. **W3 Arkansas Tech** (19-8, 9-5)—2:45 p.m.

Familiar foes clash in the second Quarter-Final game of the day. **No. 2 East seed North Alabama** and **No. 3 West seed Arkansas Tech** face off for the third time this season, but UNA posted victories in each contest. The Lions won at home in overtime, 91-90, and at ATU, 67-61. The schools match up in the Tournament for the first time ever, but UNA owns a 6-2 edge all-time.

North Alabama is no stranger to the GSC post-season, advancing to its 21st event, while compiling a 16-16 record and claiming five GSC Titles. The Lions have reached the Semi-Finals 12 times and advanced to the Finals six times. UNA is 4-2 versus the West this season and is 9-4 against the Tournament field.

Arkansas Tech posted its highest-ever seed and makes its third Tournament appearance. The Wonder Boys are 1-2 claiming their first post-season victory in last year's Opening Round. ATU is 1-2 versus East foes this year and 4-7 versus the field.

**KEY PLAYERS:** **North Alabama guard Kenny Johnson** was named the GSC East Division Player of the Year and is third in assists (5.00), seventh in scoring (15.7) and eighth in steals (1.59). **All-GSC First Team center Thomas Fraise** is second in scoring (18.1), third in free throw percentage (.826—95-115) and eighth in rebounds (7.4). Arkansas Tech is also led by an All-GSC First Team duo. **Center Thiago Cordeiro** is No. 1 in blocks (2.67) and field goal percentage (.632—122-193), while **guard Chad Henderson** is averaging 14.0 points per game.

**Game E—West Alabama/Harding winner** vs. **W1 Christian Brothers** (22-5, 11-3)—5:30 p.m.

**Christian Brothers** sewed up its first-ever GSC West Division crown last week and plays the winner of the West Alabama/Harding game.

The defending league champions seek to become the first team to repeat since Montevallo in 2004-05. CBU makes its fifth overall appearance, compiling a 4-3 record. The Buccaneers are 4-1 versus the East this season and are 8-3 versus the field. CBU is 2-12 all-time versus UWA and 29-29 versus West rival HU.

**KEY PLAYERS:** **Christian Brothers center Nick Kohs** is the GSC West Division Player of the Year, ranking first in the GSC in scoring (21.1) and rebounding (10.3) and third in blocks (tied, 1.59). **All-GSC First Team guard Reggie Peyton** is fourth in steals (1.96), seventh in free throw percentage (.796—90-113) and ninth in scoring (14.7). **Guard Kyle Couvin** is tops in steals (2.26) and fourth in assists (4.52) and **GSC West Division Freshman of the Year Scott Dennis** is seventh in rebounds (7.6).

**Game F—E3 Alabama-Huntsville** (17-10, 7-5) vs. **W2 Delta State** (20-7, 10-4)—7:30 p.m.

The final Quarter-Final game features **No. 2 West seed Delta State** and **No. 3 East seed Alabama-Huntsville**. The teams battle for the third time this season, splitting a pair of matchups. DSU one at home, 63-60, while UAH also won at home, 80-64. They met in the GSC Tournament for the second time in three seasons with Alabama-Huntsville earning a 74-69 triumph in the 2007 Opening Round.

Delta State has the most GSC Tournament appearances of any school (22) and has a 25-16 mark led by five Championships (1986, 1993, 1997, 1998 and 2006). The Statesmen are 5-2 versus East opponents this season and are 9-4 versus the field.

Alabama-Huntsville makes its ninth Tournament trip, fifth in a row. The Chargers have a 4-8 record, advancing to the 2003 Championship Game and the 2006 Semi-Finals. UAH is 3-5 versus West Division foes this year and is 6-9 against the Tournament field.

**KEY PLAYERS:** **Delta State guard Chad Akins** was named to the All-GSC First Team and tops in assists (7.07). **Guard Eric Spencer** is third in three-point percentage (.429—42-98). **Alabama-Huntsville's First Team center Cody Jones** is 10th in field goal percentage (.543—139-256) and is averaging 13.3 points and 5.7 rebounds per game. **Guard Josh Magette** was named East Division Freshman of the Year and ranks second in steals (tied, 1.96) and sixth in assists (4.04).
