Junior quarterback Scott Buisson passed for 424 yards with five touchdowns and rushed for 216 yards with two touchdowns in UAM's 51-48 win over Henderson State in 2008. Buisson was named the GSC Player of the Year after turning in another exciting performance in 2008.
