Bachelor of Music Education (Instrumental)

To be eligible for graduation with a baccalaureate degree from the University of Arkansas at Monticello, a student must file a Program of Study approved by his/her advisor upon entering the University. A Bachelor of Music Education (Instrumental) requires 143-145 credit hours. Students planning to teach should review the certification requirements provided by the School of Education. Specific degree requirements are listed at the end of this Program of Study. The Program of Study is for informational purposes only; it is the responsibility of the student to fulfill all requirements of graduation. The Program of Study is subject to change as academic program changes are needed to comply with the Arkansas Department of Higher Education regulations. NOTE: Some courses require pre-requisite and/or co-requisite classes. Some courses may only be offered during specific semesters. Contact the department chair for specific information. Students who score below the required minimum level on placement exams will be required to take additional credit hours as part of this University's developmental education program. See the current academic catalog for more information. *Courses that fulfill the General Education Requirements are in italics.*
