- Degree Audit between 70-95 hours

- 24 hours completed at UAM after senior status
- At least 9 hours at the 3000-level or above in the minor field of study
- 2.00 Grade Point Average in the Major
- At least a 2.00 overall Grade Point Average
- BS/BA Identity Requirements fulfilled
- All general education requirements fulfilled
- 2.00 Grade Point Average in the Minor
- 30 hours completed at UAM
- At least 30 hours of major coursework
