

2002 STUDENT CONGRESS SHORT TITLES

(THESE SUBJECTS CANNOT BE USED FOR BILLS IN THE 2003 STUDENT CONGRESS)

Bills for Arkansas General Assembly

Arkansas School Districts practice an extended school year schedule for grade K-12
The number of school districts be consolidated to one district per county
State Driver's licenses be encoded with optional electronic wills
Teachers in the state be fully certified within one month of being hired
The statute of limitations on all rape and sexual assault cases in Arkansas be abolished
The motorcycle helmet law be amended to include all passengers and operators of any age are required to wear safety helmets
In-Stream gravel mining be banned on crooked creek
Anyone over the age of seventy-eight take a mandatory driving test every two years
Every motorized automobile has to pass a safety inspection before it is licensed and the license must be renewed annually
Tobacco advertisements should be banned from public viewing in the state of Arkansas
Trains have time restrictions on blocking a railroad crossing
Use of Antibiotics in Arkansas Poultry farming be restricted
Act 1192 of the extended juvenile jurisdiction act be amended so that all persons ten years and older who commit first degree and capital murder be tried as an adult
Every County in the state be required to establish shelters for the victims of domestic violence
All smoking be banned in Arkansas Restaurants
Public school districts implement guidelines regulating the use of student book bags
Place a \$250,000 cap on pain and suffering in medical malpractice lawsuits
Same sex marriages be legalized and recognized within the state of Arkansas
State funded higher education institutions be required to buy back textbooks regardless of future circulation
Arkansas Commission to consolidate Arkansas School Districts be formed
Amend the law 5-14-22, decriminalizing same-sex sodomy

Bills for U.S. Congress

All businesses using the product methyl methacrylate be required to post a declaration of use within the establishment
Water desalination plants be established on the coastlines of the United States
All high schools in each school district provide daycares for children of student mothers
Proper funding for the Violence against Women Act
Public Law 107-40 be amended to preserve congressional power to declare war
School Administrators be prohibited from censoring publications within the school, unless the publication substantially interferes with the workings of the school or infringes on the rights of others
Any frivolous lawsuits put before, or in America's court system be dismissed
The national drinking age be lowered to 18 years of age
The McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigational Systems be declared the Arkansas National River and Recreational Area
Diversion courts be established for the mentally ill
E-Commerce self-regulation be abolished in favor of the adoption of privacy seals
Semi-annual physicals be required for all barge operators
National Parks be given necessary funding
Kyoto Protocol be ratified
Children must undergo medical examination before being administered immunizations
National task force in mental health reform shall be created
Daylight savings time should be abolished
Share an open border with Mexico
Police officers be required to carry air taser guns in place of batons
National school lunch program end the use of donated commodities
Students receiving federal workstudy have their hours doubled
Federal Court jurisdiction be regulated
Commission be formed to address the concerns of nations facing epidemic medical crisis and reduce the loss of intellectual property in said cases.
Fraudulent information be removed as support for evolutionary theories in the public school system
Licensing program be implemented for the purchase of a firearm
Western hemisphere institute for security cooperation be closed
Armenian Genocide of 1915 be recognized and the Turkish Government be condemned.
Internet filters be banned from installation on all federally funded public access computers
Dash-board camera installation and usage in all state patrol cars
Mexico City Policy be rescinded
Patriot act be repealed indefinitely
Condemn the use of aggressive military force
