

# ARKANSAS TIMBER HARVEST REPORT


**4TH QUARTER 2025**

The Arkansas Timber Harvest Report displays Arkansas timber severance tax data as reported from the Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration. Timber severance taxes are collected, reported, and remitted by each primary processor of Arkansas timber. It is computed based on the weight determined the last time timber is weighed prior to undergoing the first primary processing after severance. Severance totals can be submitted one of three ways: monthly (by the 25th day of the following month), quarterly, or annually. Reporting time frame varies by primary processor. ## TIMBER HARVEST TRENDS

Harvest levels were higher this quarter compared to years past, but not as high as levels in 2021. Traditionally, harvest levels during the third and fourth quarters are elevated most likely due to drier conditions during these months. Though stumpage prices were suppressed during 4Q 2025, harvest levels were higher year over year by 9% state-wide.

Northern Arkansas saw the highest harvesting levels for both pine and non-pine species. In South Arkansas, after several quarters of declining non-pine harvest levels, levels finally pulled up this quarter. Overall, compared to the previous quarter, harvest levels only increased by 1%.
