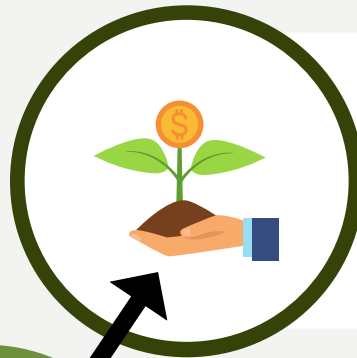


FOREST ECONOMY
