

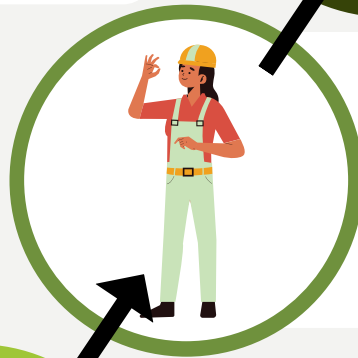
# FOREST ECONOMY

Data for Clark, Dallas, Garland,  
and Hot Spring Counties

The average annual forest compensation is **\$221,536**, or **142%** of the four counties' average

**90,368,936** tons of standing timber



**1,524,220** acres of forest
