

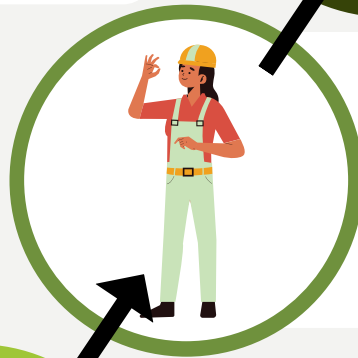
# FOREST ECONOMY

Data for Crittenden and Cross Counties

The average annual forest compensation is **\$79,832**, or **104%** of the two counties' average
