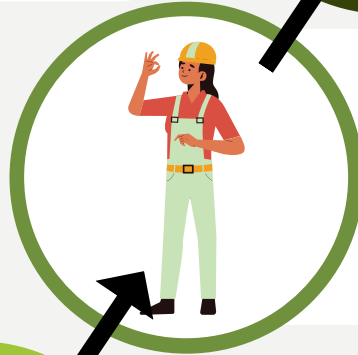


Data for Calhoun, Cleveland, Grant,
