


Figure 1. 70 and 100 mile radii around Magnolia, Arkansas.

Summary

The timber resources in the 70-miles surrounding Magnolia, Arkansas can support additional harvests greater than 4.9 million tons per year in pine saw logs and 2.5 million tons in pine pulpwood and top wood. Within 100 miles, these values increase to 8.6 and 3.5 million tons per year in saw logs and pulpwood/top wood, respectively. Annual hardwood removals could increase by 1.0 million tons in saw logs and 0.6 million tons in pulpwood and top wood, with these values increasing to 2.5 and 1.2 million tons, respectively, in a 100-mile radius. The majority of oak and hardwood timber is in grade 3 and lower trees, but growing stock in grade 1 and 2 trees is generally increasing. Grade 1 select white oaks over the last ten years have seen a net decline in sawlog volumes by 34%.

This data comes from the most recent FIA data (2019 – AR and MO) and does not reflect changes in forest cover, growth, or removals from that time to present. Changes in existing mill production and other forest disturbances could have a substantial effect on the values provided here, and those changes will likely increase over time.

Highlights of Tables

- There are 7.3 and 14.4 million acres of timberland land within 70 and 100 miles, respectively, of Magnolia, Arkansas
- Pine (52%) is the dominant forest type in the region followed by upland hardwoods (19%), bottomland hardwoods (16%), and oak/pine (11%).
- Naturally regenerated forests cover account for 63% of all forestland in the region, but 63% of pine covertypes are <u>artificially</u> regenerated. Only 8% of non-pine forests are artificially regenerated
- 92% of the forest land is privately owned and forest growing stock, growth, and removals are generally proportional to ownership
- Within 70 miles of Magnolia
 - 249 million tons of pine growing stock, 177 million tons of which is pine saw timber and 71 million tons of pulpwood and top wood
 - 176 million tons of hardwood growing stock, 97 million tons of which is saw timber and 80 million tons is pulpwood and top wood
 - o Annual surplus in pine growth is 4.9 million tons in saw timber and 2,5 million tons in pulpwood
 - Annual surplus in hardwood growth is 1.0 million tons in saw timber and 0.6 million tons in pulpwood
 - Over the last 10 years, select white oak and select red oak volumes are increasing, more than 50% of all hardwoods have a tree grade of 3 or lower. Grade 1 select white oaks have actually declined in abundance in the last 10 years. (Table 12).
- Within 100 miles of Magnolia
 - 452 million tons of pine growing stock, 322 million tons of which is pine saw timber and 131 million tons of pulpwood and top wood
 - 363 million tons of hardwood growing stock, 199 million tons of which is saw timber and 164 million tons is pulpwood and top wood
 - Annual surplus in pine growth is 8.6 million tons in saw timber and 3.5 million tons in pulpwood and top
 - Annual surplus in hardwood growth is 2.5 million tons in saw timber and 1.2 million tons in pulpwood and top wood

Purpose/Objectives

The purpose of this analysis is to create a one-time snapshot of merchantable timber around Magnolia Arkansas. The data tables attached will provide information on the following:

- Timberland area within 70 and 100 miles aerial radius of Magnolia, Arkansas by ownership and forest type group (Tables 1 and 2)
- Timberland area within 100 miles aerial radius of Magnolia, Arkansas by forest type group and stand origin (Table 3)
- Within 70 miles and 100 miles for major species groups and ownership groups:
 - Current growing stock for merchantable bole, sawlogs, and pulpwood/topwood (Table 4 and 9)
 - Annual net growth for merchantable bole, sawlogs, and pulpwood/topwood (Table 5 and 10)
 - Annual removals group for merchantable bole, sawlogs, and pulpwood/topwood (Table 6 and 10)
 - Annual net surplus for merchantable bole, sawlogs, and pulpwood/topwood (Table 7 and 11)
- Within 70 miles, the report will examine hardwood volumes by species groups and tree grade for all owners. (Table 12)

Methods

The USDA Forest Service Forest Inventory and Analysis (FIA) database is the source of the data for these tables. Data comes from the Arkansas (2019) and Missouri (2019) inventories, which, at the time of this report are the most current available. The online software EVALIDATOR and DATIM processed the database queries for these reports. EVALIDATOR and DATIM can be accessed on the FIA National Program website (https://www.fia.fs.fed.us/tools-data/).

Some specifics to the database queries are important to note:

- The center of the analysis radii of 70 and 100 miles is 33.267072 degrees north latitude and -93.239334 degrees west longitude (center of Magnolia, Arkansas)
- The results show acre and tonnages based on forestland based on FIA definition (FIADEF)
- Ownership categories are either PUBLIC or PRIVATE
- Areas are in acres
- Tree biomass is reported in GREEN SHORT TONS
- Hardwood merchantable volume is presented in International ¼ inch board feet as the database does not report tonnages. Typically, 1000 board feet in the International ¼ log rule will weigh 6.225 tons.

This report is an initial survey of forestland resources. The Arkansas Center for Forest Business upon request can provide more detailed analysis and information regarding the region.
