



Dear UAM community,

We continue to be concerned about protecting the health and safety of faculty, students and staff in light of the COVID-19 Omicron Variant.

The University of Arkansas System Board of Trustees' resolution regarding masks/face coverings continues to be in effect. Students, faculty, staff and guests, regardless of vaccination status, must wear masks/face coverings in indoor public settings where physical distancing cannot be assured in accordance with CDC guidance.

- UAM employees, students and visitors are required to wear masks/face coverings at all times in indoor settings where physical distancing is not possible.
- Vaccinations are strongly recommended for all members of the UAM community to provide the fullest protection against COVID-19. Individuals may be vaccinated by contacting the UAM Health Center for assistance and guidance, 870-224-0647.
- Disinfectants will be made available in all buildings and hand sanitizing stands are in place at building entrances. The UAM custodial staff will continue to frequently sanitize all building spaces.
