UAM has implemented the following measures to provide the safest learning environment for all of the UAM community. We would ask that you follow each one to protect yourself and others.

COVID-19 Safety Measures

Daily Health Screening:

- Complete a health screening before coming to class. Please do not physically attend class if you have any of the following symptoms.
 - fever of 100.4 or greater
- **OR**
- 1 of these symptoms of acute respiratory illness: cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing
- **OR**
- 2 of these symptoms: chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell
- You may participate in your online courses, but for in-person classes, please notify your faculty that you cannot attend due to your health screening and request to make up any missed assignments.
- We would also recommend you seek medical advice from your health care provider.
- Mainline Health Services has an on-campus location to offer rapid testing for COVID-19. You will need to call for a telephone screening before entering the facility.

Social Distancing:

- All students must socially distance (at least 6 feet) from any one that does not live in their household.
- All classroom seats will be at least 6 feet apart from any other seat. If extra seating is not physically removed, seats will be marked indicating which seats may be occupied.
- Signage has been placed throughout the facilities to assist with social distancing.

Face Coverings:

- Face coverings/masks are required to be worn by all UAM students, faculty and staff when social distancing cannot be achieved on campus. All students and faculty are asked to wear a face covering/mask in the classroom setting despite social distancing.
- Some faculty may require face coverings in the classroom because social distancing is difficult to maintain the entirety of the class.

Disinfectant Stations:

- Hand sanitizing stations are placed at the entrance to each building on campus and students should use them when entering the buildings.
- There are disinfectant supplies in the classroom if you wish to clean your desk/table before class.

Mode of Instruction:

- All instruction, including final exams, will be offered remotely after Thanksgiving Break for the remainder of the fall term, November 30 – December 10.
