HOW TO APPLY FOR UAM HOUSING



The UAM Housing online application portal **is open** to all students. Students have the opportunity to sign a contract, pay a deposit and create a profile online.

- 1. Go to the UAM Home Page: www.uamont.edu
- 2. Click on WeevilNet in the top right corner
- 3. Click the link to WeevilNet Student Self-Service
 - *Enter your login and password (refer to the IT student handout)
- 4. Click on **StarRez Housing** on the bottom of the page.
 - *This link will require pop ups and open a new page tab.
- 5. Click on **Application** at the top of the page.

*Students will be able to sign a contract, pay a deposit, create a housing profile and search for a roommate at this time. Students will receive an email at a later date with more information about when to choose a room and meal plan.

The following dates are critical so that you can get both your desired roommate and room assignment. The room selection and meal plan pages of the application will open at 10:00am on these specific dates and space will only be available on a "first come first serve" basis. If you do not pick a room or meal plan by at the end of the sign up period, they will be chosen for you.

April 27-30

Current University Apartment residents may renew their lease by renting for both the summer and the next academic year. University Apartment "Fall/Spring only" rentals are not available at this time.

May 1-3

Current campus residents may rent a University Apartment for both the summer and the next academic year. University Apartment "Fall/Spring only" rentals are not available at this time.

May 4-6

Current on-campus residents may pick their current rooms for the next academic year or sign up for University Apartments for the summer and next academic year rental only. University Apartment "Fall/Spring only" rentals are not available at this time.

May 7-10

Current students (both on-campus residents and students not currently living on campus) can pick any available room. University Apartments may be rented for the summer and next academic year only. University Apartment "Fall/Spring only" rentals are not available at this time.

May 11

All students (both current and future) can sign up for a housing assignment in any available hall. University Apartments can be rented for summer and next academic year only. University Apartment "Fall or Spring only" rentals are not available at this time.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT: All first time full-time students attending the Monticello campus who are less than 21 years of age are **required to live on-campus** for the academic year. This policy is not applicable to students enrolled at the Colleges of Technology at Crossett and McGehee; however, students attending those campuses do qualify and are welcome to reside in University Housing.
